Proposal to Increase the Permanent Capacity of Hadley Learning Centre Primary Phase from 420 to 630 Places

In accordance with the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation Regulations 2013, a proposal is being published by Telford & Wrekin Council, Addenbrooke House, Ironmasters Way, Telford, regarding the provision of primary education in Hadley.

The proposal is an enlargement of the premises to increase the capacity of Hadley Learning Community Primary Phase from two forms of entry (total 420 pupils) to three forms of entry (630 pupils). The school's published admission number will permanently increase from 60 to 90 pupils per year group. This will take effect in the reception year group from September 2016 and the increased admission number will progress up the school, year by year.

This proposal has been made in response to the increase in pupil numbers that are expected to arise as a result from the new housing developments that are planned for north Telford.
